GENERAL INFORMATION

- Type:** Appointed by the SPL
Term: 6 Months
Reports to: ASPL
Description: The Axe Yard Man ensures that all wood tools are being used safely.
Comments: The Axe Yard Man sets up and takes down the axe yard – ensuring that all tools are in good working condition and put away each evening. He helps teach new scouts to earn Tot'n Chip. Sees to it that all rope is fused or whipped, and coiled for storage. He will monitor scouts for proper usage of wood tools.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Age:** 13 or older
Rank: First Class or above
Experience: has earned Tot'n Chip and demonstrated wood tools safety skills
Attendance: 50% over previous 6 months
Participation: Fundraisers & Service Projects

PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Training:** You must attend the troop Junior Leader Training even if you have attended in the past.
Attendance: You are expected to attend 50% of all troop meetings, outings, and service projects. If your attendance is low you can be removed from office.
Effort: You are expected to give this job your best effort.

GENERAL LEADERSHIP RESPONSIBILITIES

- Uniform:** Set the example by wearing your uniform correctly. This means that you will wear all of the parts of the troop uniform, shirttail tucked in, with all required badges in their correct locations.
Behavior: Set the example by living the Scout Oath and Law in your everyday life. Show Scout Spirit in everything you say and do.
Attendance: Set the example by being an active Scout. Be on time for meetings and activities. You must call the Senior Patrol Leader or Scoutmaster if you are not going to be at a meeting or if you suddenly have to miss an outing. You also need to make sure that someone will assume your responsibilities.
