Effective immediately, Troop 90 will now accept credit and debit cards for paying camping, dues and other expenses.

The Troop Committee on June 6, 2011 unanimously approved the acceptance of credit/debit cards subject to the following fee schedule:

- **Card present and swiped:** Face amount **plus** 3% convenience fee
Example: \$150.00 summer camp payment will be charged as \$154.50
- **Card not present (manual entry):** Face amount **plus** 4% convenience fee
Example: \$150.00 summer camp payment will be charged as \$156.00
- **Straight donations:** Face value, **no** convenience fee
Example: Aunt Sally wants to make a \$100.00 donation, will be charged as \$100.00
- **Eagle Project donations:** Face amount, **no** convenience fee
Example: Uncle Tim wants to donate \$200.00 for Billy's Eagle Project, will be charged as \$200.00, however Billy's Project will net \$194.50 (assuming a swiped transaction, \$192.85 if entered manually)

Accepted cards: *US-issued Discover, MasterCard, VISA, AmEx.
HSA and flex-spending accounts are not accepted.*

The first time you use a particular card, you will be asked to enter a valid email address or a phone number (for text messages). This will provide you a link to view your receipt.

Your credit-card statement will show the merchant as either "SQUARE" or "Sq *BSA Troop 90"

All transactions are handle by Square (squareup.com) using SSL & PGP technology. No credit card information is stored or retained by either Square or Troop 90
